6 the crime of GRAND THEFT in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 487(a), a Felony, was
7 committed by Defendants US FRAMING WEST, INC and THOMAS GREGORY ENGLISH,
8 who did unlawfully take money and property of a value exceeding Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars
9 (\$950), to wit, Two Million Five Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Nine
10 Dollars and Sixty-Eight Cents (\$2,577,289.68) from the State of California.

3 Furthermore, the offenses alleged in Counts 1 – 22 are related felonies, a material element
4 of which is fraud and embezzlement, which involved a pattern of related felony conduct, and the
5 pattern of related felony conduct involved the taking of, and resulted in the loss by the State of
6 California, Conrado Alavez-Aquino, Silvano Alvarez-Aquino, Eleazar Andes, Gumercindo
7 Andes-Morales, Sergio Arroyo-Medina, Ramon Avilez, Carlos Bandera, Ada Bran, Esvin Bravo,
8 Eliseo Cruz, Juan Carlos Dedios Perez, Enrique Garcia, Antonio Garcia-Aquino, Lucas Garcia-
9 Sancehz, Fidel Miralrio, Ezequiel Moreno, Javier Murgia, Jeronimo Trujilio, and Israel Valdez,
10 of more than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), to wit, a total loss of Two Million, Six
11 Hundred Eighteen Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars and Seventy-Nine Cents
12 (\$2,618,624.89) thus subjecting the Defendants US FRAMING WEST, INC and THOMAS
13 GREGORY ENGLISH to the additional punishment provided for in Penal Code section
14 186.11(a)(2).

16 **EXCESSIVE LOSS OVER \$100,000**

17 It is further alleged that the offenses alleged in Counts 1 – 22 constitute theft of over
18 \$100,000, within the meaning of Penal Code section 1203.045(a).
